

**Some Additional History:**

Disco Di was born in Toronto and was raised primarily by her mother (immigrated to Toronto from Ecuador), as her father (immigrated to Toronto from Kenya) left the home when she was 3 years old. Her mother and father reunited when she was 12 years old. Disco Di currently lives with her mother and her father in downtown Toronto. She had a younger sister, Carol, who was killed by a drunk driver when Disco Di was 11 years old. During the intake interview, Disco Di reported a difficult childhood, having few friends and often relied on her sister for companionship and safety. During the interview, Disco Di reported feeling anxious (increased heart rate, sweaty palms, hands shaking). She reported feeling the same way each day when working at her father's company. She indicated that she has extended family living in Welland, Ontario (who she visits once a year during the winter holidays) and has no other family contact. After her last inpatient hospitalization, Disco Di was given a diagnosis of Major Depressive Disorder and a diagnosis of Borderline Personality Disorder.
