Essay instructions:

Your thesis should do the following things:

- 1. Respond directly to the prompt. It should not repeat exactly what is in the prompt, but should provide a clear answer to the question that you will elaborate on in the rest of the paper.
- 2. Contain specific information that your reader can expect you to discuss later in the paper.
- 3. For your papers, I ask you to talk about two early cultures within the theme of your paper. (Prehistoric cave art & Gothic art era)

you should find a useful source in the databases and submit an MLA citation for that source along with a brief summary of what the source says and how it fits with your paper.

I. Introduction

- a. Attention getter: There are many benefits to creating art, studies have shown that creating art increases the level of dopamine in your brain, annihilates stress, stimulates imagination and even helps with problem solving.
- b. In this essay I will be writing about why people create, starting with why prehistoric people drew in caves, and the history of daguerreotype and how photography came to be.
- c. Thesis statement: Art has been around for thousands of years and it only keeps evolving. Theres a reason for why art has been around for centuries, it's a way of expressing ourselves, our history and our culture. There are also many benefits that come from

creating, art can raise our dopamine levels making us happier, even if you're not an "artist" there are many benefits to taking time out of your day to draw. Include 2 historical examples that will be discussed in essay.
