- 2. Look for evidence during the lesson that relates to the following questions:
  - a. How does the teacher **connect** to students' prior knowledge, **develop interest** in the lesson and set lesson expectations?
  - b. What instructional strategies does the teacher use to build understanding of the concept or skill?
  - c. What learning activities do the students participate in to build understanding of the concept or skill?
  - c. What materials/resources/educational technology are used to help students learn the content?
  - d. How does the teacher incorporate **developmental considerations** and **cultural and linguistic resources** and **funds of knowledge** into the lesson?
  - d. How did the teacher **adapt** the curriculum to meet the needs of English language learners, students with special needs, or gifted students?
  - e. How does the teacher **assess** student understanding during the lesson <u>and</u> at the end of the lesson?
- 3. Write a 2-4 page paper for the observation that includes:
  - a. Name of the teacher observed, school, grade level, and subject area
  - b. A summary of the lesson observed including answers to the questions listed above
  - c. Reflections about the observation that include answers to the following questions:

  - What aspects of the lesson went well?
  - What aspects of the lesson might you change and why?
  - What insights did you gain about teaching from the observation?
