Prompt: Write a descriptive essay describing what would happen if you applied Gladwell's 10,000-hour rule to your life, your subjects, and your future goals. Gladwell's rule means studying at least 3-4 hours a day on a particular subject or field for 10 years. That would cause you to master any subject or field.

This essay will call for you to examine yourself. How much quality time do you spend studying each day? When do you start homework? What time to you turn off everything and solely focus on the task at hand (homework, writing, studying, meditating)?
